Suggestions to consider when designing a logo:

- ☑ Is there some architectural feature in your building or something of local prominence that you can feature?
- ☑ How about bringing in the local art teachers & get kids involved in a contest? There's some great PR/program opportunities here.
- ☑ In contrast, others caution against having a "logo contest," unless your community has a number of graphic artists who are willing to design pro bono. You get what you pay for.
- ☑ Consider asking your local newspaper's print shop to design a logo.
- ☑ Use the logo everywhere: on staff shirts, mousepads, book bags, etc.
- ☑ Hire an advertising firm or graphic designer to work on institutional identity; including logo, library card, and letterhead, as well as a recommended font and internal forms.
- ☑ Make a solid effort to get rid of the old versions of things.
- ☑ Make sure the design you select works well in black and white as well as color, on paper as well as on a computer screen.
- "Libraries still mean books to most people."
- ☑ Some criteria to give to the designing artist
 - 1. has to have something to do with books.
 - 2. simple and clean
 - 3. fast loading on a web page while still looking good.

Selecting a Tagline to Promote the Library

TaglineGuru has released the results of a survey identifying the 100 most influential slogans and 30 most influential jingles introduced since the advent of broadcast television in 1948. "Got Milk?" was voted number one from among more that 300 submitted nominations. The slogan was created for the California Milk Processor Board in 1993.

The survey's goal was to determine which slogans demonstrated a timeless quality. A number of factors tend to influence how much a slogan becomes part of our collective consciousness including:

- * Use of grammar (Nobody doesn't like Sara Lee)
- * Rhythm (The quicker picker-upper)
- * Rhyme (Don't get mad, get GLAD)
- * Inflection (They're gr-r-reat!)
- * Metaphor (This is your brain. This is your brain on drugs. Any questions?)
- * Attitude (The few, the proud, the Marines)
- * Ulterior meaning (Nothing comes between me and my Calvins)
- * Positioning (The uncola)
